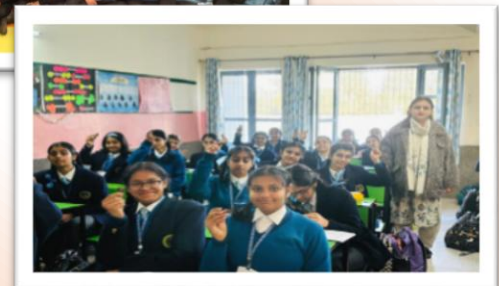
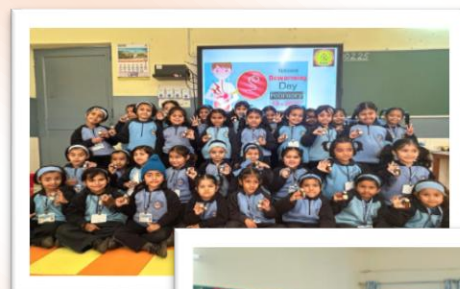
Robotics Exhibition: AI and Innovation in Action

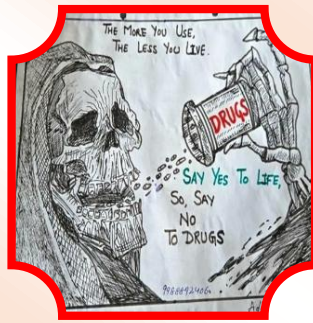
Deworming Campaign

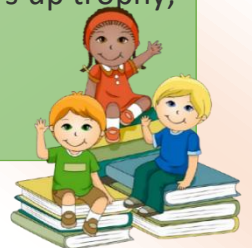

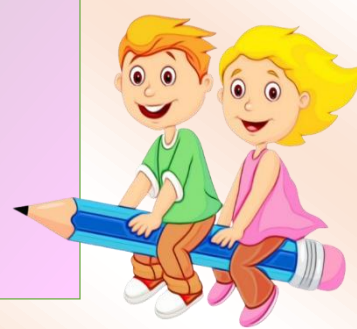

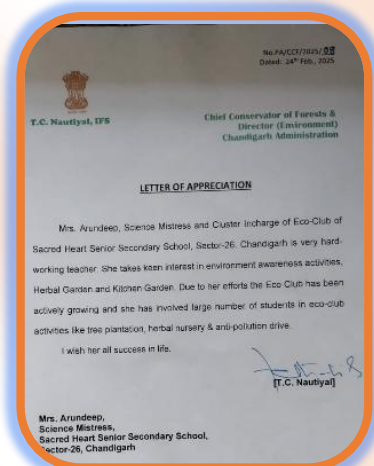


Symphony of success: Ms. Ruby's Record-Breaking Feat!
